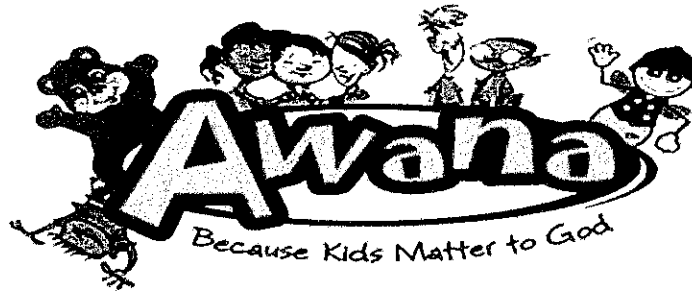

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

We are excited to launch the 2025–2026 Awana year! We are looking forward to seeing the kids' smiling faces and to interacting with them once again! Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to minister to your child/children. Awana will begin on Wednesday, September 17th at 6:30 PM and will end at 8:00 PM.

Here is some important information with you regarding our Awana clubs that will help make the Awana year go smoothly:

- 1) We are asking all clubbers to enter through the "Main Entrance" of the church and to go to their individual club tables to register each night of Awana. **Parents, please walk in with your child** each night to register them.
- 2) Please be prompt in picking up your child/children right at 8:00 PM. We again ask that you **come in and pick them up** from their designated classrooms at end of the night and keep them with you until you head home. **Parents, not siblings, should only be picking up kids from their class.**
- 3) To help with the oversight of the children, we are asking that the children not be dropped off before 6:15 PM. We will open the doors for clubbers at 6:15 PM to enter the building.
- 4) We, like many schools, will have safety procedures in place. We will have sanitation stations around the building and will strictly enforce our sick child policy. Also, if your child stayed home or went home from school for being sick, we would ask that they not come to Awana that night either.
  - a. Sick Child Policy: Children with the following symptoms should not participate in Church Events:
    - i. Fever (temp over 100.4), diarrhea, or vomiting within the last 48 hours.
    - ii. Green or yellow runny nose
    - iii. Eye or skin infections
    - iv. Other symptoms of communicable or infectious disease.

b. Medications Policy

- i. It is the policy of THBC not to administer either prescription or non-prescription medications to the children under our care.
- ii. Exceptions may apply for those with life-threatening conditions. Please advise Awana staff of these issues.

- 5) Our weather cancellation policy corresponds with Cadillac Public Schools policy. If Cadillac Schools are canceled because of weather on the Wednesday of Awana, all THBC Wednesday programming will be cancelled as well.
- 6) If you have a specific question or concern regarding a particular club, please call the church office at 231-775-4942 and we will pass on your question and contact information to the appropriate director.
- 7) We are often asked about the fees for Awana per child: THIS YEAR our church is able cover the cost of club for all clubbers.

## **Awana Child Discipline Procedure**

*Parents,*

*Please review these things with your child so that they are familiar with what the expectations are for them during our Awana club.*

### **Club Rules:**

- 1) **BE KIND** (no name-calling, no pushing or shoving, no mean attitudes)
- 2) **Be Respectful in Obedience** (follow directions immediately with a good attitude, no foul language, take care of the church property)
- 3) **Be Appropriate** (behave in a way that honors God, dress appropriately, stay in your group)
- 4) **Be Involved** (participate in all the activities, come with book and lesson worked on, come ready to have fun)

### **Discipline Steps**

**5 Count** – Whenever a leader begins to count from 1 to 5, all children must stop talking and what they are doing and give their attention to the leader speaking. This should easily gain everyone's attention by the time they reach 3 or 4.

**3 Count** – this will be used for those who continually misbehave during the night.

- A gentle warning will be given when a child begins to misbehave (Not following one of the 4 rules above)

A **"1"** Count will be given to the child who continues to act out after the warning as been giving. They will be moved away from the group to sit with a leader.

A **"2"** Count will be given, if, after being moved away, they continue to act out. This will result in a conversation with an Awana Director or Pastor. Parents, you will also be notified of this when you pick your child up.

A **"3"** Count will be given if the child's behavior still has not improved after talking with a Director or Pastor. The child will be removed from the group for the rest of the night, and parents may be called to come and pick them up early.

Our goal is for every person who comes to Awana to grow closer to the Lord and to enjoy the Awana club experience. Disruptive behavior keeps others from being able to meet that goal, so those who continually choose to be disruptive will be encouraged not to return.

Thank you for reviewing these expectations with your son or daughter. We look forward to getting to know them better and have them learn more Truth from God's Word this year.
